ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: The Youth Empowerment Champions will be charged with the following roles and responsibilities:

- 1) Mobilize the youth and their community in which the project is being implemented to ensure beneficiary buy in and active participation in Youth Empowerment Project Activities.
- 2) Facilitate mobilization of youth groups from the selected project areas to participate in capacity building, training, lobbying and advocacy and creation of relevant and strategic linkages aimed empowering youth
- 3) Sensitize Youth and Youth Groups on the concept and principles of youth empowerment while ensuring that there is proper understanding of the same by relevant community stakeholders.
- 4) Perform duties to assist in the preparation, delivery and monitoring of project activities through the organized youth groups.
- 5) Attends to weekly project meetings for mentoring, coaching and monitoring.
- 6) Builds capacities of Youths and Youth Groups members on relevant aspects such s grass root lobby and advocacy, and other social, economic and political issues affecting the youth in the community.
- 7) Maintain regular communication with members of project staff and ensure good relations and linkages between USK /partners and the community members.
- 8) Attend project, community and stakeholder meetings at the community level.
- 9) Generation of monthly project reports for adequate monitoring and support.
- 10) Attend and participate in monthly reflection meeting with Project implementation teams
- 11) Perform any other duties as requested by relevant program supervisors.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a member of an active youth group
- A person of youthful age (15-35 years)
- Basic education with ability to read, write and calculate. At least completed secondary education
- Must be ready and willing to adhere to USK's child protection policy
- A resident of Ntitaru West, Ntitaru East, Nyabasi East Gokeharaka/ Getambweka, , Nyabasi West – who can identify well with the group members as well as having a good grasp of the youth situation in the community.
